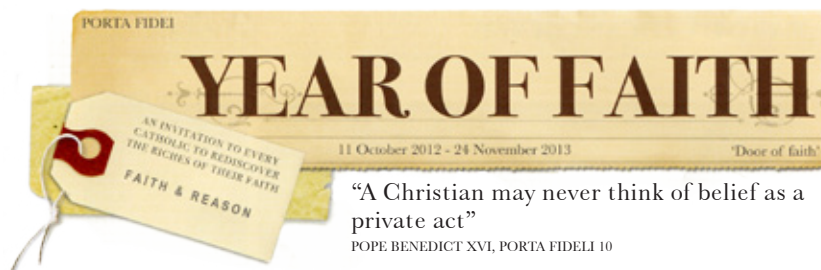

APOSTOLIC LETTER "MOTU PROPRIO DATA"

PORTA FIDEI OF THE SUPREME PONTIFF BENEDICT XVI - FOR THE INDICTION OF THE YEAR OF FAITH

CONTINUATION OF "PORTA FIDEI" (DOOR OF FAITH)

We cannot accept that salt should become tasteless or the light be kept hidden (cf. Mt 5:13-16). The people of today can still experience the need to go to the well, like the Samaritan woman, in order to hear Jesus, who invites us to believe in him and to draw upon the source of living water welling up within him (cf. Jn 4:14). We must rediscover a taste for feeding ourselves on the word of God, faithfully handed down by the Church, and on the bread of life, offered as sustenance for his disciples (cf. Jn 6:51). Indeed, the teaching of Jesus still resounds in our day with the same power: "Do not labour for the food which perishes, but for the food which endures to eternal life** (Jn 6:27). The question posed by his listeners is the same that we ask today: "What must we do, to be doing the works of God?*" (Jn 6:28). We know Jesus' reply: "This is the work of God, that you believe in him whom he has sent" (Jn 6:29). Belief in Jesus Christ, then, is the way to arrive definitively at salvation.

In the light of all this, I have decided to announce a Year of Faith. It will begin on 11 October 2012, the fiftieth anniversary of the opening of the Second Vatican Council, and it will end on the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, Universal King, on 24 November 2013. The starting date of 11 October 2012 also marks the twentieth anniversary of the publication of the Catechism of the Catholic Church, a text promulgated by my Predecessor, Blessed John Paul II, with a view to illustrating for all the faithful the power and beauty of the faith. This document, an authentic fruit of the Second Vatican Council, was requested by the Extraordinary Synod of Bishops in 1985 as an instrument at the service of catechesis and it was produced in collaboration with all the bishops of the Catholic Church. Moreover, the theme of the General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops that I have convoked for October 2012 is "The New Evangelization for the Transmission of the Christian Faith". This will be a good opportunity to usher the whole Church into a time of particular reflection and rediscovery of the faith. It is not the first time that the Church has been called to celebrate a Year of Faith. My venerable Predecessor the Servant of God Paul VI announced one in 1967, to commemorate the martyrdom of Saints Peter and Paul on the 19th centenary of their supreme act of witness. He thought of it as a solemn moment for the whole Church to make "an authentic and sincere profession of the same faith"; moreover, he wanted this to be confirmed in a way that was "individual and collective, free and conscious, inward and outward, humble and frank". He thought that in this way the whole Church could reappropriate "exact knowledge of the faith, so as to reinvigorate it, purify it, confirm it, and confess it". The great upheavals of that year made even more evident the need for a celebration of this kind. It concluded with the Credo of the People of God, intended to show how much the essential content that for centuries has formed the heritage of all believers needs to be confirmed, understood and explored ever anew, so as to bear consistent witness in historical circumstances very different from those of the past.

Fr. Leslie writes

Today we celebrate the feast of the Baptism of the Lord. It has a form of an Epiphany – a manifestation of who Jesus is. For many the idea of a Baptism is essentially about the forgiveness of sin, and that may make the baptism of Jesus superfluous – after all as we are told in the letter to the Hebrews "Jesus is like us in all things but sin". However the Christian theology of Baptism is much richer than simply relating to forgiveness of sins. Baptism is also the sacrament of which you become a beloved child of God more perfectly. And the voice from heaven in today's gospel can be applied to the Christian at Baptism. You are my son/daughter the beloved; my favour rests on you. Baptism is also acknowledged as the origin of all Christian mission and ministry – and it is as Jesus responds to his baptism by beginning his saving Ministry, so the Christian, because of baptism, is called to proclaim God's word and offer service in the world.

So as we celebrate our liturgy today on this final Sunday of the Christmas season, what have we learned this year about who Jesus Christ is for us?

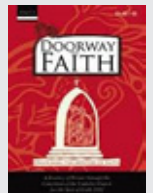

THE SUNDAY OBLIGATION

"The precept of the church specifies the law of the Lord more precisely: on Sundays and other Holy Days of Obligation the faithful are bound to participate at Mass. For this reason the faithful are obliged to participate in the Eucharist, unless excused for a serious reason (for example, illness, the care of infants) or dispensed by their own pastor. Those who deliberately fail in this obligation commit a grave sin. Catechism of the Catholic Church.
