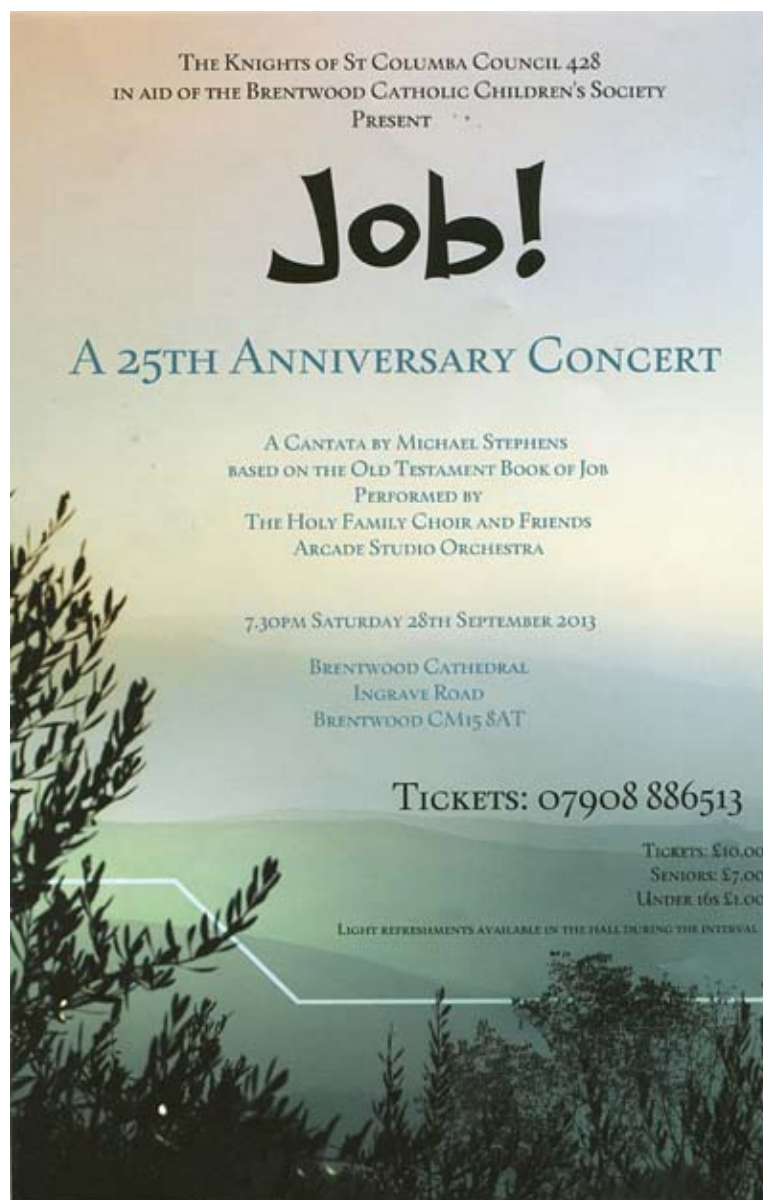

Fr. Leslie writes

Welcome to all our parishioners and visitors. Today we celebrate the great feast of Saints Peter and Paul. In front of the Basilica of St Peter's in Rome are two imposing statues of St Peter with the Keys of the Kingdom in his hand and of St Paul with the Sword of Truth. They remind us that we are both a Petrine and Pauline church.

Tradition has always held that Peter and Paul are inseparable as together they represent the whole gospel message. We know that both men were weak and frail in human nature. Peter was impulsive and emotional. Paul led a brutal persecution against the early believers. Peter was transformed by the outpouring at Pentecost; Paul was transformed by meeting Jesus on the road to Damascus. In today's gospel Jesus give Simon Peter the keys to the kingdom with the promise that the gates of hell will not prevail against the church. The church is a community of sinners; we are all weak and fallen. However, it is God's grace and mercy which brings healing and restoration, and ultimately it is God's grace which will continue to protect the church.

For us we have to recognise in our life what God is doing now to bring about his kingdom and to recognise Christ's mercy and grace.
