Fr. Leslie writes

Welcome to all our parishioners and visitors. I hope you all enjoy our Mass, and a very happy Easter to each and every one of you. Today and during the Easter Season our Scriptures are so rich. John Paul II said "on Easter

Sunday, the church is reconnected in contemplation of the risen Christ. She feels imbued with the same wonder as Mary Magdalene and the other women who went to the tomb on Easter morning and found it empty. That tomb became the womb of life. Whoever had condemned Jesus deceived himself that he had buried his cause under a tombstone. The disciples themselves gave into the feeling of irreparable failure. We understand their surprise, then, and even their distrust in the news of the empty tomb. But the Risen Lord did not delay in making himself seen and they gave into reality. They saw and they believed. Two thousand years later, we still sense the unspeakable emotion that overcame them when they heard the Masters greeting "Peace be with you".

Christ's resurrection is the strength, the secret of Christianity. It is not a question of mythology or of mere symbolism, but of a concrete event. It is confirmed by sure and convincing proof. The acceptance of this truth, although the fruit of the Holy Spirit's grace, rests at the same time on a solid historical base. On the threshold of the third millennium, the new effort of evangelisation can only begin from a renewed experience of this mystery, accepted in faith and witnessed to in life".

For us as we journey together towards Pentecost Sunday in this special Year of Faith, we will experience the truth of the resurrection, penetrating and taking hold of us in a deeper and more life changing way than ever before.

Our faith is tested, sometimes sorely and severely. The disciples had come face-to-face with the Risen Lord and even Thomas, at first deeply sceptical, declared "My Lord and my God". However it was only when the Spirit came down upon the disciples at the feast of Pentecost that they were able to proclaim with heartfelt joy and confidence that Jesus was risen from the dead.

So let us celebrate with joy this wonderful event that changed human history and has the power to transform our lives each and every day.

Thank you, God Bless, and have a great Easter.

Their work ranges greatly from trauma counselling to legal advice and practical day to day support. In our Connect2 village of Musha and the area surrounding it, Avega East has given trauma counselling to about a hundred people. Day to day support includes help with medication and other necessities.

We at CAFOD, the team at Avega East, and the people we are connected to through Connect2: Rwanda want to thank you for your generosity, support and friendship."

Please continue to keep the people of Rwanda in your prayers and to support them financially with your spare change as much as you can.

FROM KEITH FERNETT, DIRECTOR, ANCHOR HOUSE

We are very grateful to the congregation of St. Joseph The Worker for the collection of £276.31 on Homeless Sunday and for your longstanding support. It is because of the fantastic support of your church and parishioners that we can continue to support the vulnerable and highly marginalized single homeless people who stay at Anchor House.

At Anchor House we support people each year by providing a stable and safe environment. We offer a holistic programme of rehabilitation including vocational skills training. We do this currently in a building that is now over 50 years old. That is why we launched our ambitious £15.3m Home and Hope Appeal to provide an inspiring environment with purpose built facilities. We are based in Canning Town, the most deprived ward in London Borough of Newham, and third most deprived borough in England & Wales. Newham has one of the highest rates of homelessness and unemployment in the UK. The high unemployment rates are linked to acute levels of skill shortages. Together with our residents over 1000 local people access our in-house accredited vocational training courses to NVQ Levels 1 & 2 either in construction or Literacy, Numeracy, IT and ESOL.
